### प्रस्तावना -

स्वयंअर्थसहाय्यित तत्वावर नवीन शाळा स्थापन करणे तसेच विद्यमान शाळेचा यथास्थिती, उच्च प्राथमिक किंवा माध्यमिक किंवा उच्च माध्यमिक शाळेस दर्जावाढ करणेसाठी परवानगी देण्याकरीता तरतुदी करणे, तसेच अशी नवीन शाळा स्थापन करण्यासह, विद्यमान शाळेचा दर्जावाढ करणे, त्याकरीता अर्ज मागविणे, व विहित पद्धतीने परवानगी देणे, यासाठी महाराष्ट्र स्वयंअर्थसहाय्यित शाळा (स्थापना व विनियमन) अधिनियम २०१२ (सन २०१३ चा ०१) पारित केला असून सदर अधिनियम शैक्षणिक वर्ष २०१३-१४ पासून अंमलात आला आहे. तसेच, सीबीएसई, आयसीएसई, आयबी, आयजीसीएसई आणि सीआयई इत्यादी शिक्षण मंडळाच्या अभ्यासक्रमाशी संलग्नित होण्यासाठी इच्छुक असणा-या इंग्रजी माध्यमांच्या शाळांना कायम विनाअनुदान तत्वावर परवानगी व नाहरकत प्रमाणपत्र देण्याकरीता दिनांक २० जून, २०१२ रोजीच्या शासन निर्णयान्वये विस्तृत कार्यपद्धती निश्चित करण्यात आलेली आहे.

स्वयंअर्थसहाय्यित तत्वावर खाजगी नवीन शाळांना शैक्षणिक वर्ष २०१४-१५ करिता नविन शाळा मान्यता देणे, विद्यमान शाळांचा दर्जा वाढ करणे याकरीता दिनांक ०८ ऑगस्ट, २०१३ पर्यंत अर्ज मागविण्यात

आले होते. सदर प्रस्तावांची छाननी करुन पात्र प्रस्तावांवर पुढील कार्यवाही करण्याची बाब शासनाच्या विचाराधीन होती. सर्व बाबींचा विचार करुन शासनाने पुढील प्रमाणे निर्णय घेतला आहे.

१. महाराष्ट्र स्वयंअर्थसहाय्यित शाळा (स्थापना व विनियमन) अधिनियम, २०१२ (सन २०१३ चा ०१) अन्वये सन २०१४-१५ या शैक्षणिक वर्षाकरीता प्राप्त झालेल्या एकूण ३७०० प्रस्तावांपैकी खालीलप्रमाणे एकूण २२१७ प्रस्तावांना याद्वारे शासन मान्यता देत आहे.

१.१ नवीन शाळा परवानगी व शाळांचा दर्जावाढ - या सोबतच्या विवरणपत्र- अ मध्ये दर्शविलेल्या शाळांना, शैक्षणिक वर्ष २०१४-१५ पासून, नवीन शाळा स्थापन करणे आणि विद्यमान शाळांचा दर्जावाढ करणे याकरीता याद्वारे शासन परवानगी देत आहे.

१.२.अपात्र शाळा- नवीन शाळा स्थापन करणे किंवा विद्यमान शाळेचा दर्जावाढ करणे यासाठी अपात्र ठरलेल्या प्रस्तावांच्या तपशीलासह संबंधित जिल्ह्याच्या छाननी समितीच्या सदस्य-सचिवांकडून संबंधित अर्जदार संस्थेला वैयक्तिरित्या कळविण्यात येईल .

#### २. शासन परवानगी/शाळांचा दर्जावाढ करण्याच्या अटी व शर्ती -

२.१ प्राथमिक व उच्च प्राथमिक शाळांनी बालकांचा मोफत व सक्तीच्या शिक्षणाचा अधिकार अधिनियम, २००९ व या अंतर्गत केलेले व केले जाणारे सर्व नियमांची /तरतुदींची पूर्तता करणे आवश्यक आहे.

२.२ पात्र ठरलेल्या संबंधित शाळांच्या व्यवस्थापनांनी अधिनियम, २००९ मधील तरतुदींची पूर्तता करुन सन २०१४-१५ या शैक्षणिक वर्षात शाळा सुरु करण्यास खालीलप्रमाणे परवानगी देण्यात येत आहे.

अ) ज्या व्यवस्थापनाकडे शाळा स्थापन करण्यासाठी किंवा दर्जावाढ करण्यासाठी शासनाच्या विहित नियमानुसार आवश्यक असलेल्या सर्व बाबींची पूर्तता आहे अशा व्यवस्थापनांनी शैक्षणिक वर्ष सुरु झाल्यापासून एक महिन्याच्या आत प्रथम मान्यतेसाठी संबंधित जिल्ह्यांच्या शिक्षणाधिकार्यांकडे अर्ज करावेत.

ब) ज्या व्यवस्थापनास सन २०१४-१५ करिता या शासन निर्णयाद्वारे पात्र ठरविण्यात आले आहे. अशा व्यवस्थापनाकडे शाळा स्थापन किंवा दर्जावाढ करण्यासाठी शासनाच्या विहित नियमानुसार आवश्यक असलेल्या सर्व बाबी उपलब्ध नसतील तर त्यांना सदर बाबींची पूर्तता करण्यासाठी या शासन निर्णयाच्या दिनांकापासून **अठरा महिन्यांच्या** आत शाळा सुरु करणे बंधनकारक राहील अन्यथा दिलेली परवानगी आपोआपच **रद्दबातल** ठरेल.

क) सीबीएसई, आयसीएसई, आयबी, आयजीसीएसई आणि सीआयई इत्यादी शिक्षण मंडळाच्या अभ्यासक्रमाशी संलग्नित होण्यासाठी इच्छुक व्यवस्थापनास / शैक्षणिक संस्थेस शासनाने पात्र ठरवून परवानगी (Permission) दिलेल्या संस्थांनी शासन निर्णय दि. २० जून, २०१२ मध्ये विहित केलेल्या सर्वकष धोरणानुसार **ना-हरकत प्रमाणपत्र (N.O.C.)** मिळविण्यासाठी प्रथमतः शाळेस मान्यता (Recognition) घेणे आवश्यक राहील. शाळांना अशी मान्यता (Recognition) सदर शासन निर्णयातील परिच्छेद (१०) नुसार जिल्हा शिक्षणाधिकारी (प्राथमिक)/ जिल्हा शिक्षणाधिकारी (माध्यमिक) /शिक्षण निरीक्षक, बृहन्मुंबई यांचेकडून मिळाल्यानंतर मान्यता पत्रासह संस्था संबंधित मंडळाच्या **संलग्नता ना-हरकत प्रमाणपत्र (N.O.C.)** मिळविण्यासाठी शासनास अर्ज करेल. सदर अर्जाची छाननी करुन सदर संबंधित शाळा विहित निकष, अटी व शर्तीची पूर्तता करित असल्यास शासन शाळेस मंडळ संलग्नतेसाठी **ना-हरकत (N.O.C.)** प्रमाणपत्र देईल.

- २.६ संस्थेने शाळा परवानगीसाठी मागणी केलेले **माध्यम**, शाळेचे **ठिकाण** इत्यादी मध्ये भविष्यात कोणताही बदल करता येणार नाही. शासनाने ज्या ठिकाणासाठी शाळा परवानगी दिलेली आहे त्या ठिकाणा व्यतिरिक्त अन्य ठिकाणी शाळा सुरु केल्यास शासनाने दिलेली परवानगी आपोआपच **रद्द** समजण्यात येईल.
- २.७ यु-डायस डाटा- या शासन निर्णयाद्वारे परवानगी देण्यात आलेल्या नवीन शाळा / दर्जावाढ शाळा बाबत जिल्हानिहाय U-DISE(Unified District Information System for Education) मध्ये माहिती भरताना,

"स्वयंअर्थसहाय्यित तत्वावरील परवानगी प्राप्त शाळा" म्हणून स्वतंत्र प्रवर्गात नोंद करून क्रमांक प्राप्त करून घेण्याबाबतची जबाबदारी संबंधित संस्थेवर राहिल. याबाबतची पुढील कार्यवाही करण्यासाठी राज्य प्रकल्प संचालक, महाराष्ट्र प्राथमिक शिक्षण परिषद, मुंबई यांना नोडल अधिकारी म्हणून घोषित करण्यात येत आहे. त्याचप्रमाणे, संस्थेने, सर्व संबंधितांच्या माहितीकरीता " स्वयंअर्थसहाय्यित तत्वावरील परवानगी प्राप्त नवीन शाळा/ दर्जावाढ परवानगी प्राप्त शाळा" असा जाहीर फलक शाळेच्या बाहेर प्रवेशद्वारावर लावणे आवश्यक राहिल.


